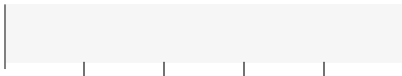

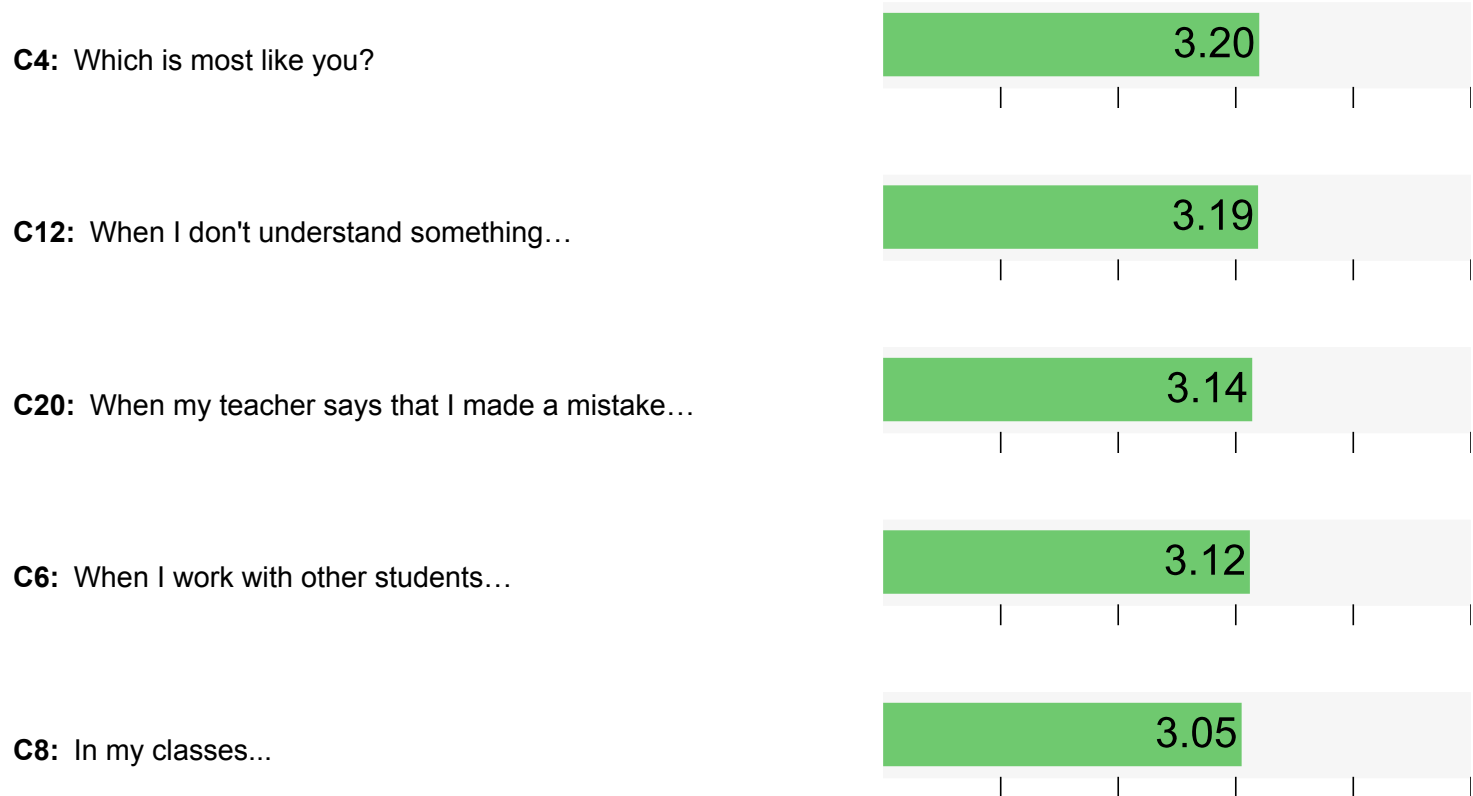

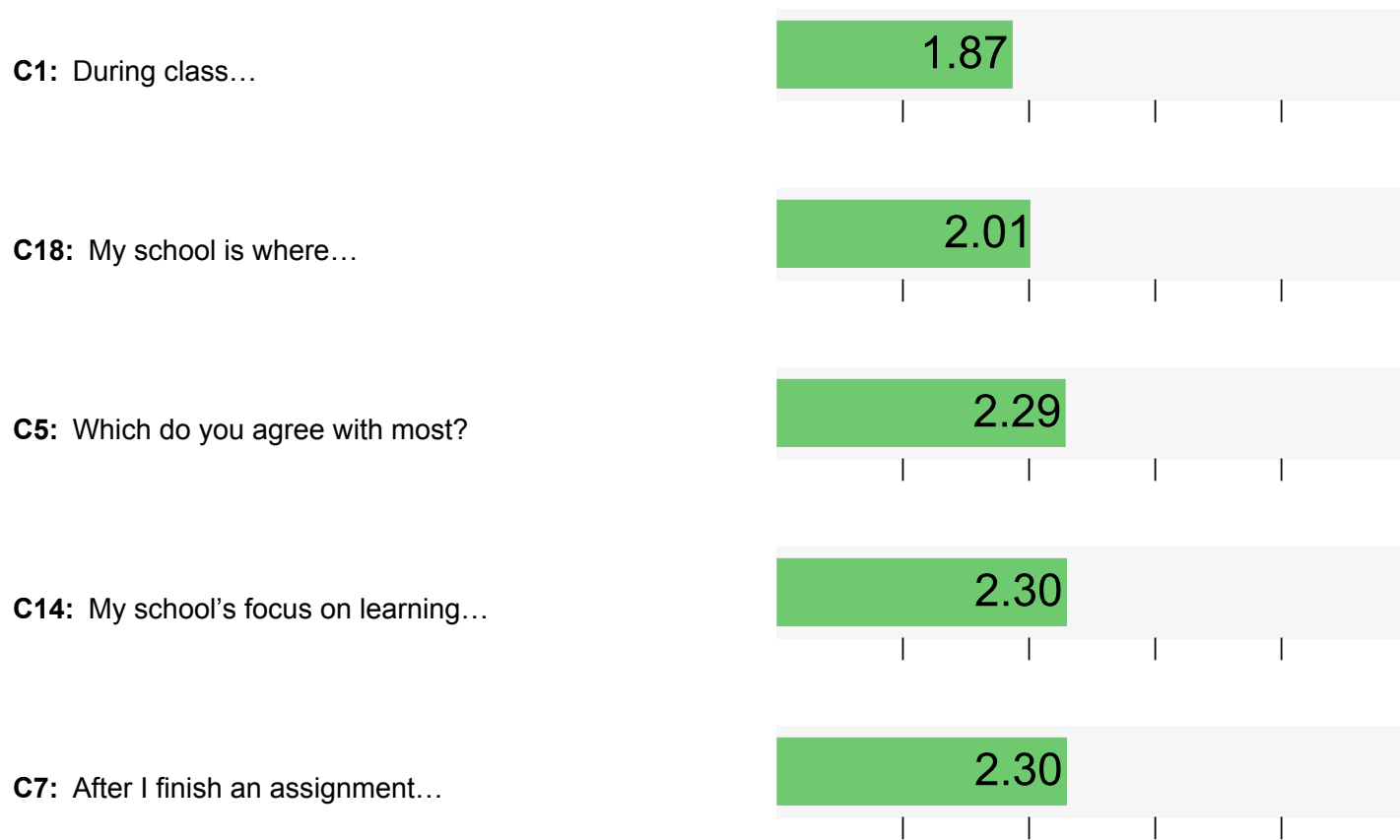

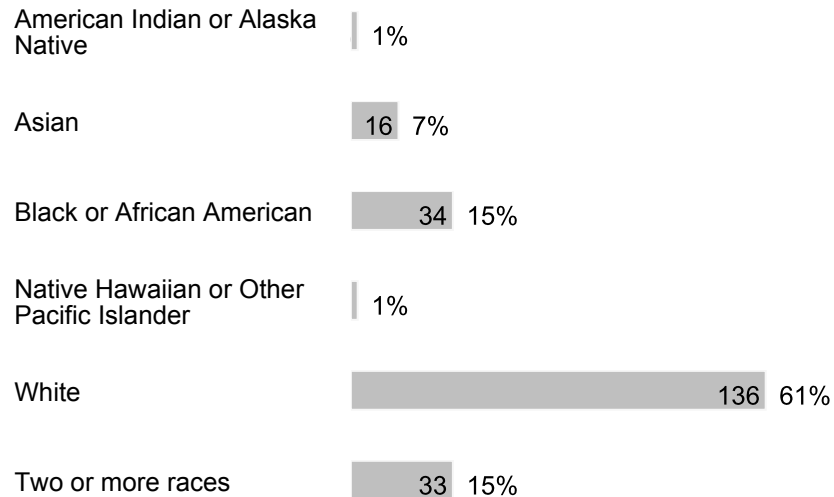

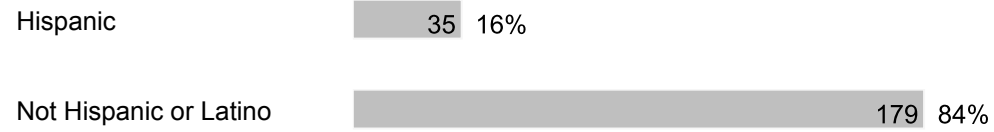

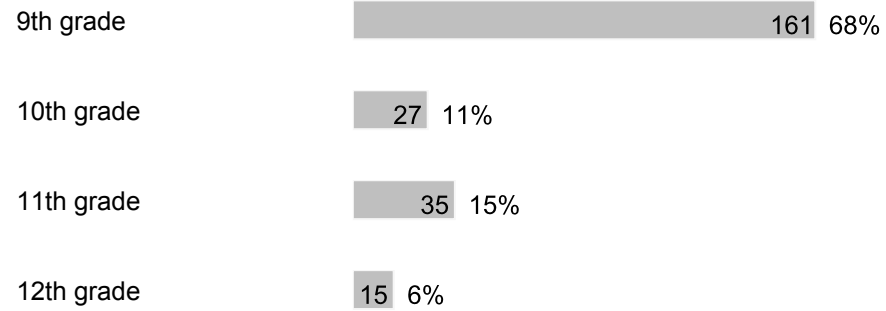

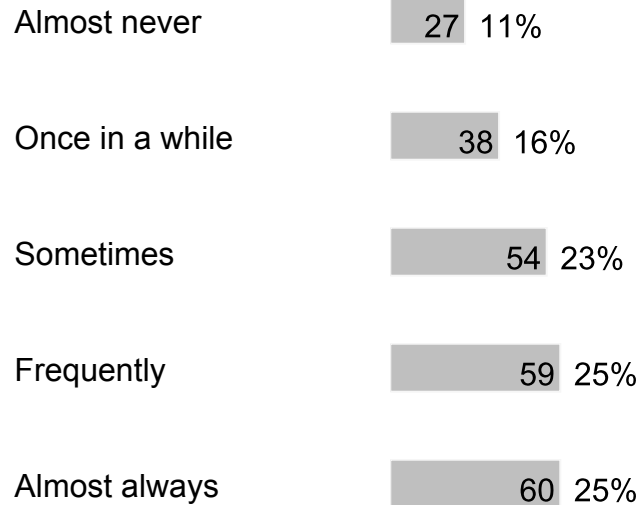

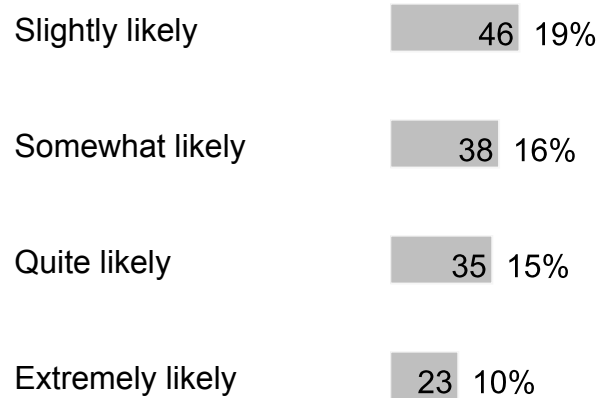
1. How often are people disrespectful to others at your school?

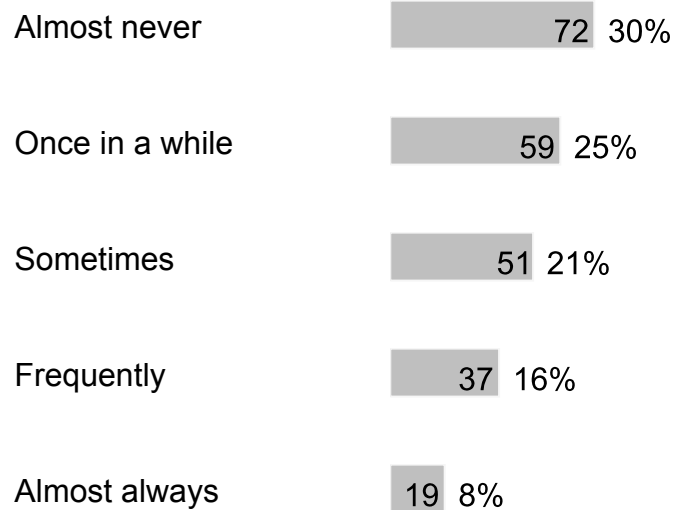
2. How likely is it that someone from your school will bully you online?

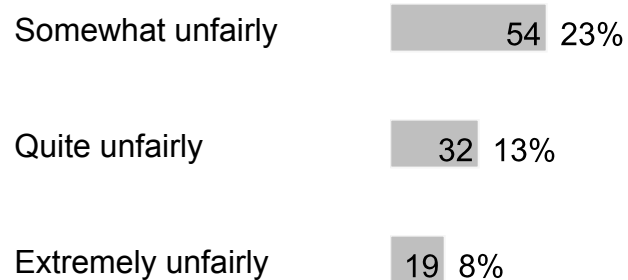
3. How often do you worry about violence at your school?

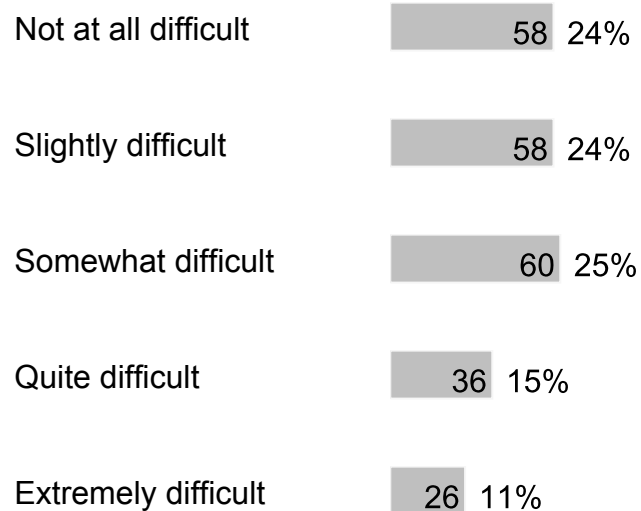
4. At your school, how unfairly do the adults treat the students?





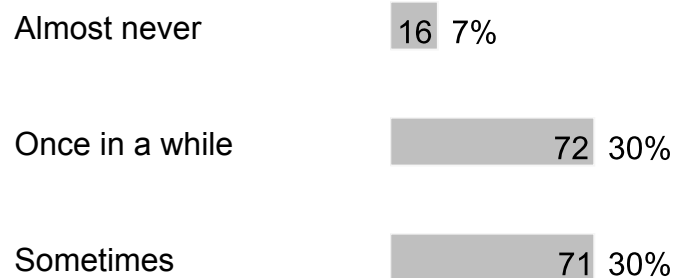
